

Ridge Augmentation Example

The patient has been missing tooth #20 for many years with resultant bone resorption. The adjacent teeth are sound and do not require restorations, so a single tooth implant is planned to replace #20. There is inadequate height and width of alveolar bone to allow placement of the implant.

Ridge augmentation (D7950) is needed in order to increase the volume of the residual ridge and allow implant placement (D6010).

The ICD-9 diagnosis codes to use for this claim are:

- 525.22 – moderate atrophy of the mandible
- 525.13 – loss of teeth due to caries
- 525.51 – partial edentulism, class I
