

## Treatment for Peri-implantitis Example

An implant was placed three years ago on tooth #12. The patient has developed a 7mm pocket around the implant. The recommended treatment is code D6102 – debridement and osseous contouring of a periimplant defect; includes surface cleaning of exposed implant surfaces and flap entry and closure. Also, code D6103 – bone graft for repair of periimplant defect – not including flap entry and closure or, when indicated. Placement of a barrier membrane or biologic materials to aid in osseous regeneration may also be used. D4266 – guided tissue regeneration – resorbable barrier, per site will be placed.

The ICD-9 diagnosis codes to use for this claim are:

- 525.72 – post-osseointegration biological failure of dental implant
- 525.25 – moderate atrophy of the maxilla
- 525.51 – partial edentulism, class I
