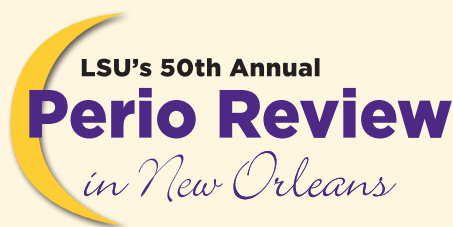

The LSU's 50th Annual Perio Review is a comprehensive continuing dental education program designed to support periodontists preparing for certification by the American Board of Periodontology (ABP) Oral Examination (Part II), as well as practicing clinicians seeking to enhance and update their knowledge in periodontics.

This evidence-based program provides a structured review of contemporary concepts in periodontal diagnosis, treatment planning, and patient management, with emphasis on advanced periodontal disease and dental implant therapy.

The program includes two participation options: a 2½ day comprehensive review and update, and an extended 4-day experience that includes an additional 1½ days of mock oral board examinations. *A live stream option is available for the 2½ day course.*

This activity is intended for periodontists, general dentists, and dental specialists with an interest in periodontics who seek to enhance clinical competence and remain current with evolving standards of care.

After completing this activity, the learner will be able to:

- Evaluate current concepts in the management of advanced periodontal disease and dental implant therapy.
- Analyze emerging developments and key topics in periodontics to support clinical decision-making.
- Assess the impact of systemic diseases on periodontal conditions
- Recognize and manage common medical emergencies in the dental setting.
- Differentiate oral lesions and apply appropriate diagnostic considerations.

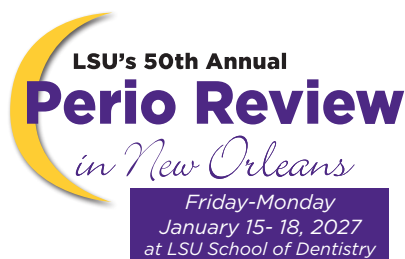
